

We offer greetings and a warm welcome from Norton. We offer here a summary of our general customs and practices in worship.

#### Congregation

Our congregation usually numbers about 15 adults.

#### Music

The music books available are 'Complete' Mission Praise (to number 1021 only) and Hymns and Psalms. If you wish to reproduce the words or music of a song in any form, please ensure that it is covered by CCL.

#### Readers

There is a limited number of readers who are willing to read Bible passages, prayers, poems, drama or dramatic readings.

#### Worship Area and Other Information

The chairs curve to face the pulpit during regular worship. The Preacher/Minister can choose to either use the lectern or the pulpit. We have a clip-on microphone as well as a microphone at the pulpit. The notices are usually read out before the service. The senior steward or steward on duty will contact the Preacher/Minister in advance for hymns and readings.

#### Christmas

For the first 5 minutes of the service, the steward leads us in observing the Advent season by lighting Advent candles, reading a prayer and singing different verses appropriate for the Advent week.

#### Easter

For the first 5 minutes of the service, the steward leads us in observing the Lenten season by adding various objects to the cross that reflect Jesus' journey to the cross. During this observation there is a short hymn, a reading, a congregational response, and another short hymn.
