

STOTFOLD METHODIST CHURCH

Our services are on a Sunday morning at 10.00am and usually last for about 1 hour. We hold a communion service once a month.

Car parking is available on-site and in the lay-by in front of the church in the High Street.

The main church is situated on the first floor and can be accessed by a lift from the ground floor. The church has a public address system which incorporates a loop system for the hard of hearing.

Our hymn book is 'Singing the Faith'. We usually have an organist to play for us and if not available we use a digital organ which provides most of the required hymns. It would be helpful to let us know the hymns and any readings required by Thursday.

We have a flip chart and an overhead projector with a screen. Please let the steward know if you would like to use these.

There are 'Good News' bibles in the pews. Please could you announce page numbers to allow people to follow the readings. Members of the congregation are happy to read if given due notice. If you would like readers, please let the steward know when you are giving them the hymns.

The steward on duty will offer the preacher a vestry prayer and will then introduce the service, give out any notices and introduce the preacher. At the end of the service, we share fellowship over tea and coffee and would be pleased if you could join us.
